Students have been doing a great job getting back into the routine, even with the crazy schedule the last couple of weeks. 😊

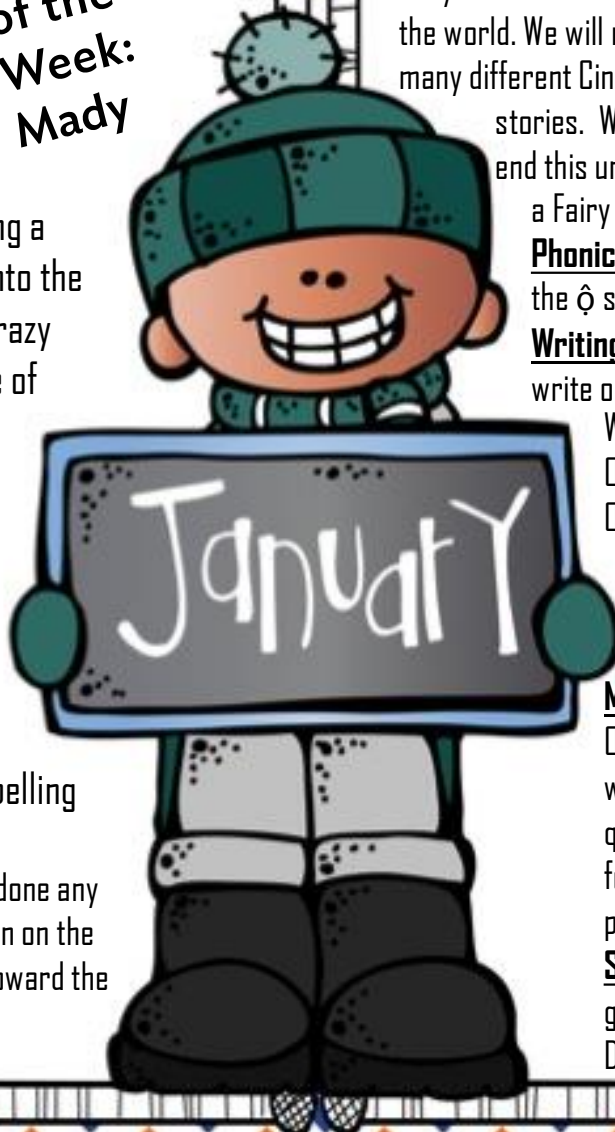
